Dr. Dargès is interventional electrophysiologist at the German Heart Center Berlin in Germany. He has a particular research focus on sudden cardiac death: he is co-leader of the large EU funded PROFID project and international chief investigator of the PROFID EHRA randomized trial studying contemporary strategies for primary prevention of sudden cardiac death after myocardial infarction. He is also the deputy chair of the steering committee of the RESET-CRT randomized trial comparing CRT-D with CRT-P in patients with heart failure. He is member of the Board of the European Heart Rhythm Association.
